

Sauntering with JOYCE



- 1** **JAMES JOYCE STATUE** St. Stephen's Green
Located at the centre point of the southern path inside the Green.
- 2** **MOLI - MUSEUM OF LITERATURE IRELAND**,
No. 86 St. Stephen's Green
Where James Joyce studied, and now the home of Ulysses edition No1.
- 3** **ST. STEPHEN'S GREEN**
Joyce is knocked to the ground here and part of Mr. Bloom is born.
- 4** **THE SHELBOURNE**, 27 St. Stephen's Green
A historic location significant to several Joycean stories.
- 5** **OSCAR WILDE'S CHILDHOOD HOME**
American College Dublin, 1 Merrion Square North
- 6** **HOLLES STREET HOSPITAL**
The location of Episode 14 of Ulysses – Oxen of the Sun.
- 7** **ST ANDREW'S CHURCH** 44 Westland Row
Mr. Bloom enters here in Episode 5 – The Lotus-Eaters.
- 8** **SWENY'S PHARMACY**, 1 Lincoln Place
Where Bloom buys a bar of lemon soap.
- 9** **FINN'S HOTEL**, 1 Leinster Street South
Nora Barnacle's place of work in 1904.
- 10** **THE ALLIANCE FRANÇAISE**, 1 Kildare Street
Previously The Kildare Street Club, an exclusive men's club for landed gentry in Joyce's time.
- 11** **NATIONAL LIBRARY**, 7-8 Kildare Street
The location of Episode 9 of Ulysses. Joyce also read here often while at University.
- 12** **DAVY BYRNE'S**, 21 Duke Street
Bloom has his lunch here in Episode 8 – Lestrygonians.
- 13** **MARKS & SPENCER**, 20 Duke St
In Joyce's time this was Brown Thomas.

Our tour has no rules. Follow it in whatever way you wish. You may simply stand outside the locations and move in time to saunter with the audio, you may prefer to enter each location and spend a longer time inside before continuing with the tour, or you may prefer just to sit back and let the audio do all of the sauntering for you.

Either way, just pause the audio at any point if you fall out of synch with it and press play again when you are ready to re-join. A bit like reading Ulysses, you can take it at your own pace.

There are numerous other locations of Joycean significance you might like to explore yourself on this route, like The Academy building on Pearse Street where Joyce sang (along with the tenor John McCormack), or the National Museum where Mr. Bloom goes to check the statues for a particular attribute. We hope our tour engages, entertains and perhaps even leads you towards the enormously rewarding activity of reading the works of James Joyce.
